Audio-Visual

- PowerPoint slides will be provided at least 48 hours in advance of the event and should be loaded to the conference computer system and pre-checked prior to Rico's arrival.
- Rico normally arrives 45 - 1 hour before his presentation for an A/V check; preference would be to accomplish this without attendees not in the room. However, if that cannot be accommodated, an alternative time can be arranged.
- Rico requires a wireless lavalier microphone for any group more than 25 people. A confidence monitor and countdown clock are strongly preferred.
- For keynote addresses and speaking, Rico prefers to have a podium at the front of the stage, and may move around the stage for maximum audience engagement.
- To have the highest-energy presentation, a single screen or double screens should be off to the side or well above the stage, not center stage because the presenter is the focal point and the slides are merely supplemental.

Slides & Handouts

- Please note Rico prefers not to convert his slides to a standard templates. Templates may dilute the emphasis that is designed to graphically supplement his verbal content.
- Rico's slide deck(s) are not available for download, or for publishing as notes or a handout. If you need an outline of the presentation for educational certification requirements, one can be provided on the day of the session.
- Rico owns and retains all rights to his materials and content. They cannot be reproduced or distributed.

Scheduling & Logistics

- To create some anticipation for the session and to allow for AV setup and testing (discussed above) it's best to schedule a break before Rico takes the stage, if possible.
- Also consider scheduling a break right after Rico's presentation. It helps facilitate the opportunity for people who want to ask questions, and share their epiphanies. Plus, you get break-time conversation for people to discuss what they just learned.
- Because travel delays happen, Rico prefers to arrive the night before. Please arrange or recommend a hotel that's either at the venue or closer to the airport than the venue itself. Please book a non-smoking room on a high floor with late checkout guaranteed. Car service should also be scheduled.

Recordings & Photos

- Feel free to take as many flash photos as you'd like before the talk, but please no flash during the presentation.
- You agree that Rico and his team have the right to photograph the session, as well, and use the photos online or in print.
- If we've agreed to permit recording of the session, plan ample time to test sound pick up and to verify that the sound patch doesn't interfere with the projection-output quality (sometimes an issue).
- Unless you specifically agreed to work it out, you don't have the ability or right to record and then resell or distribute Rico's presentation to non-attendees (virtual or in-person).
